Questions to encourage independence!

Read the question; what is it asking of you?

How do you think that you might answer the question?

What resource has your teacher given you to help you answer the question (for example: a word bank, a mathematics model, an explanation, success criteria or steps to success)?



PRACTISE

Give your child time to practise without your attention.



GUIDED PRACTISE

If your child is asking for your help, read the question or instructions with your child and then encourage your child to explain what is being asked of them.

Help your child to answer the first question and talk about the steps that your child took in order to arrive at the answer.

CHILD-LED

Stay with your child to answer the next question but allow your child to lead this process with your prompts/clues to help them remember how to answer the question.
