Information for parents regarding our Summer Fayre

Date: Tuesday 18th July 2023

Time: from 1.30- 3.30 pm.

Non-uniform days

Monday 17th July will be a non-uniform day in exchange for cake donations for our cake stall at the summer fayre on Tuesday.

Tuesday 18th July will also be a non-uniform day so that the children can attend the fayre and enjoy the afternoon in their own clothes.

Arrangements for the day of the fayre

Children will be required to attend school in the usual way on the morning of Tuesday 18th July. The children will be able to have school dinners and lunch in school as they normally would.

However, school will close to ALL children at 1.20pm on the day of the fayre. All children will need to be collected by parents at this time. If another adult will be collecting your child at 1.20, please could you let the office know in the usual way. NO CHILDREN WILL BE ALLOWED TO WALK HOME ALONE AT THIS TIME.

Dismissal Arrangements

The children will be dismissed at 1.20pm from the following places:

Class 1- dismissed through their outside area, in the usual way.

All other pupils will be dismissed through the doors at the back of the school hall (where the children enter for breakfast club in the mornings). Please be advised that you will then need to make your way towards the school playground, either to visit the fayre or to exit the premises.

Where and when is the fayre in the afternoon?

The fayre will be held on the playground and the field. The playground gate at the back of the school will open at 1.30pm!

There will be lots of exciting things to do at the fayre including:

candy floss, ice cream, refreshments, games, a bouncy castle, tombola, barrel of booze (adults over 18 only - ID may be requested) and splat the teacher.

Tokens

We will not be taking money at the stalls. We will be operating a token system, which will make queuing at stalls much simpler and hopefully will reduce wait times at the stalls. This is a sample token:



Mrs Scamp will be giving these out in exchange for cash. Tokens will be available in £2, £3 and £5 (*tokens will also be available to buy at the first aid stall situated near the bouncy castle*). Tokens will be available at these two locations for the duration of the fayre, so you can go back at any point to purchase more. You can take these tokens around with you and present them at each stall. If you are spending 50p, the adult running the stall will cross off one of the 50p's. If you are spending £1, they will cross off two of your 50p's etc.

Pre-purchasing tokens

If you wish to avoid queuing at the start of the fayre for tokens, the school office will have tokens available from Monday to pre-purchase.

Safety at the fayre

Just a polite reminder to parents that the children will be your responsibility during the school fayre and we ask parents to closely supervise their children at all times, in order to keep everyone safe.

Children will need to follow school staff instructions/safety rules when taking part in games/on the bouncy castle etc. If children are not behaving in a safe way, they may not be able to continue with the activity/game. This is for the safety of everyone.

We also like to remind parents that smoking/vaping on the school site is not allowed anywhere and no alcohol is allowed to be brought on to, or consumed on the premises.

First Aid if anyone does require First Aid during the fayre, there will be a First Aid point by the bouncy castle.

If the weather is warm, please remember to bring sun cream and hats!
